



Ivel Valley Year 7 Catch-Up Funding 2017/2018

The Year 7 Literacy and Numeracy Catch-up Premium is provided by the Government and is based on the number of Year 7 pupils who did not achieve the National Standard in reading and/or mathematics at Key Stage 2.

Year 7 Catch up Funding 2017/2018

For the year 2017/2018 we predict to receive £7000 under the Year 7 Catch up scheme.

We will have 14 Year 7 pupils in our school during the period 2017/2018. Due to their SEND none of these pupils achieved the national standard.

Based on the needs of the Year 7 pupils for 2017/2018, we will implement the following programme to support their learning. Intervention will be based on each pupils individual and identified needs.

- Continuation of 1:1 teaching intervention for targeting phonics, sight reading and comprehension skill.
- Continuation of Conquer maths programme to the catch up cohort to use both at home and school to target specific maths skills.
- Introduction of an online English support programme which offers 1:1 accounts for pupils.
- Additional TA support in class to support small group reading and spelling support
- Additional intervention based on individual need.
- Continuation of speech and language programmes for identified pupils and time allocated for staff to work with pupils to reinforce programme across the school week.
- Identify specific training needs of staff within this Key Stage including Numicon for new teachers and TEACCH training (5-day TEACCH course).

What is the anticipated impact on the attainment of pupils who attract the funding?

- All pupils will make progress against their Year 6 assessments. Pupil progress is assessed using a combination of W S P steps, observations, regular pupil progress meetings and teacher judgements.
- To increase staff knowledge and skills which will impact on progress of pupils.
- Pupils will meet their speech and language targets as set by a speech therapist.
