



Creativity Ideas



- With Easter coming - create an Easter card or decoration using materials. You could also make Easter nests or melt chocolate and decorate various biscuits.
- Make an Easter tree - find a branch and paint white - or leave as it is to hang your Easter decorations on.
- Decorate eggs together.
- Use materials that are going into the bin for junk modeling.
- Find some different large stones (if you can) and decorate them.
- Various baking recipes (trying to use what's in the cupboard) or just allow your child to explore mixing various ingredients.
- Create a piece of art from materials gathered from a walk or the garden.
- Make various different types of dough - explore different textures, changing the colour etc. (Lots of different recipes online).
- Make different instruments using kitchen items - pots and pans for drums etc.
- Make a collection of one colour and create a collage or just a collection to explore.
- Use a large box to create a 'feely' box (ideas on Pinterest) - guess what is in the box.
- If you have paint at home - explore different ways to make marks e.g. using a fork, potato masher.
- Leaf printing (if you have paint).
- Shaving cream painting - mixing paint into shaving foam and making a print by pressing paper onto the shaving foam.
- Create a still life picture and work on pencil control.
- Divide a piece of paper into squares and explore different ways to make marks with a pencil.
- Draw a self portrait or draw a member of the family.
