

Art & Creativity



- Try some shadow drawing in the lovely sunshine - can use any objects.
- Make a musical instrument using items from your recycling.
- Make a rainbow collage using cutting from magazines, cereal boxes, bits of materials etc.
- Create a mobile for the garden using things you find on a nature walk or items from recycling.
- Use newspapers/magazines to cut out shapes to create your own character.(see above).
- Create blow painting creatures (see Picture below).
- Use one shape and either by drawing or cutting lots of the same shape create a shape picture or collage.
- Use a blank silhouette of a bare tree and add blossom by using cotton buds dipped in pink paint.
- Another way to create some lovely flower/blossom painting is by dipping the end of a plastic bottle into paint. (see picture).
- Messy Art - Use paint in bubble mixture. Blow the bubbles in a bowl and press paper onto bubbles to make bubble art.



- Paint on different surfaces - newspaper, cardboard, leaves, foil etc.
- make some frozen art - freeze flowers and take photos of them, explore how they change as the ice melts.
- Create a special card for someone nearby so you can deliver this on a walk.
- Collect some wild flowers whilst out on a walk and draw/paint a picture of them.
- Make your own mini art sketchbook to make drawings of things you see when in your house, garden or out for exercise.

- Make up your own words to a favourite song or learn to sign to a new song.
- Explore different ways to print flower patterns using things from around your house. E.g. a fork print makes a good tulip shape.
