Introduction and Aims

Ivel Valley is a school for pupils with Complex Learning Needs. It offers education for pupils with Moderate Learning Difficulties, Severe Learning Difficulties, Profound & Multiple Learning Difficulties and also other complex difficulties such as autism, who may also have challenging behaviours.

- The school provides education for pupils from 3-19 years.
- All pupils attending the school have an Education, Health & Care Plan. Occasionally pupils are admitted on an 'assessment' placement pending the completion of Special Educational Needs assessment.
- Admissions to the school are decided and managed by the Local Authority
- Decisions regarding the placement of pupils in our satellite classes are made by the school in conjunction with parents / carers and any other relevant professionals
